CSEA NO-COST BACHELOR'S DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM

Complete your Bachelor's Degree online

CSEA and Central State University are offering the chance to complete a bachelor's degree online from an accredited university at no-cost.

What are the requirements?

Applicants must have an Associate degree or at least 60 transferable credits to be considered. Students who do not meet this requirement can complete needed courses through the CSEA Free Associate Degree Program. Students must stay continuously enrolled in at least one course each term to complete their degree at no-cost for tuition, books, and fees.

How does the financial side work?

The benefit is a "last-dollar scholarship", or grant, that fills the gap between any federal, state or employer education grants you receive and the cost of tuition, fees and e-books for certain online bachelor's degree completion programs at Central State University. Every applicant is required to complete the FAFSA in order to determine the amount of the "last-dollar scholarship" that will be applied to their tution, fees, and e-books. Even if the applicant does not qualify for federal or other grants, they will still be eligible for this scholarship benefit.

What can you study?

Degrees are currently offered in Education, Business Administration, and Criminal Justice. Additional degree programs are coming soon.
